Fiesta Bean and Cheese Dip

Bake Time: 15 minutes

- 1 package (8 oz) cream cheese, softened to room temperature**
- 1/2 cup Heinz tomato ketchup**
- 1 packet (1.25 oz) taco seasoning mix**
- 1 can (16 oz) Heinz Homestyle Brown Sugar & Bacon Beans**
- 1 package (8 oz) Colby and Monterey Jack cheese blend, shredded and divided**
- 1 can (4.5 oz) chopped green chiles, drained**

Preheat the oven to 425 degrees.

In a large bowl, mix together the cream cheese, ketchup and seasoning mix until smooth.

Stir in the beans, 1 1/2 cups of the cheese blend and the chiles.

Transfer to a greased 1 1/2-quart baking dish.

Sprinkle the remaining 1/2 cup of the cheese blend evenly on the top.

Bake uncovered for 15 to 20 minutes or until the cheese is melted and lightly browned.

Serve warm.
