Tostado D'Oeuvre

2 packages (8 ounce ea) cream cheese, softened 2 cans (16 ounce ea) chili without beans chopped olives OR green onions shredded Monterey Jack cheese

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees.

In a 9x13x2-inch casserole dish, layer the olives, green onions and cheese in that order, using the amount that you prefer.

Bake for about 25 minutes.

Serve with plain tostada chips.
